# EYFS learning for this term.

# English:

The children will enjoy listening to a wide range of stories in reading time at the end of the day where children will have the opportunity to vote for their chosen book as well as other opportunities to listen to stories during the day.

We have already begun our phonics lessons and will send weekly updates on tapestry of the sounds we are covering each week as well suggestions of 'Fred Talk' games you can play with your children.

In our Talk for Writing sessions, we will look at the traditional tales 'The Little Red Hen' and 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'.

## Maths:

In Maths we will begin by building on children's prior mathematical experiences. We will be matching sets of objects using 1:1 correspondence, as well as identifying uneven sets. We will also be looking at how to represent numbers 1-6 over the autumn term and adding and subtracting with numbers up to 6.

## Learning at Home:

#### English:

Read daily to your child, bedtime stories are an excellent opportunity for this.

Support your child in their developing phonics understanding by consolidating sounds sent home on the weekly update via tapestry.

Play Fred Talk games (examples of these will be given in updates and in phonics information session)

Talk to you children about their day, encourage children to talk in full sentences.

### Maths:

Look for numbers in their environment- door numbers, road signs, in supermarkets etc.

Support children 1:1 correspondence by counting small groups of their toys eg. cars, dolls.

Play board games eg. snakes and ladders, dominoes other games using a dice. Encourage children to recognise side of dice by sight.

### **General information:**

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle with them each day. This should only contain water and not squash or juice.

Fruit is available in the classroom for snack time, children are also welcome to bring in a piece of fruit or veg (cucumber/ carrot sticks etc.) for their snack. Milk is available at snack time for children.

Please ensure all children's clothes are clearly labelled with their name including school shoes.

If you have any questions or queries, please don't hesitate to get in touch with your child's class teacher. We can't always chat on the gate due to needing to ensure safety of children arriving and leaving school, but we are always happy to arrange a meeting time, just send an email.
