#### **EYFS News**




EYFS have had a great start to the spring 2 half term. We have begun by learning about water for the last 2 weeks. We have been looking at the different ways we use water, the different places we find water and begun to learn about the water cycle. We have created our own raindrops in art, reading a range of water-based stories, created our own rain gauges to measure rainfall, as well as lots of water play!

In our Maths sessions we have been looking at numbers beyond 10 and finding 1 more and 1 less than a given number as well as accurately counting amounts of objects. We have also been using our number knowledge to solve simple problems.

In our drawing club this half term we have looked at the book lost and

found by Oliver Jeffers and written some fantastic sentences to describe the boy in the story as well as thinking of different arctic animals we would like to meet.
