Year 6 News


This week, Year 6 took part in a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) challenge trying to create effective gliders as part of the Road to RIAT (Royal International Air Tattoo 2025). Following an online Live lesson, the children designed and built 3 different gliders in their groups. Once built, they tested them and tested how far and fast their gliders could fly. The furthest distance recorded was and amazing 16m!

Next week, we the children are taking part in a competition to design a sustainable aircraft for the future. The day has been a wonderful experience for all who took part. They have learnt about airplane/glider design and how to place wings on an aircraft. Using what they learnt, everyone was successful in designing and building a glider which swooped away in the school hall. We are looking forward to the Summer term when we can take part in stage 3 and meet people who have careers in STEM.

Year Two's Great Fire of London Day

On Thursday 6th March, Those History People visited Bassingbourn and delivered a workshop all about the Great Fire of London in 1666. Phil took us right back to 1666, whereby we pretended to be in London at that time.

We wrote a letter to King Charles II using feather quills and ink, we made soap, scent bags, clay pendants, pamphlets, hammered our name into leather and we even made our own candles. We had to put out the fire using water from the well in fabric bags and we also had actual smoke! Daisy did a great job stopping the fire from spreading by throwing a bomb into the centre of the fire!

We had to collect rats and some of us even got to be soldiers with muskets! In the afternoon, we became archaeologist's, carefully removing items from the soil and labelling them. We found all sorts – wooden bobbins, a key, shells, wooden peg doll and knuckle bones! We had such a fun day. Here are some photos from our day:


