Knowledge Organiser - Textiles
Artist: Matisse

Key Enquiry Questions:	
How can materials be decorated?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Materials can be painted or printed onto, they can be batiked or tie dyed.
What are the different ways to create a wall hanging?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You could stick or sew materials and make a collage, you could applique fabric or quilt it and you can use a combination of these.
How do you create different patterns using tie dye?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are different ways to fold, tie and knot the fabric to create different patterns.

Key Vocabulary	
applique	A decoration of one material sewn or fixed onto another.
batik	Comes from a word that means to draw or write – batiks are ‘written’ - the parts of fabric to be dyed are covered by wax.
collage	Materials are pasted onto a flat surface.
dye	Substances that impart colour to fabrics or other materials.
dyebath	Receptacle where fabrics are mixed with dye.
embroidery	Decorative needlework – often a picture or pattern.
felt	A matted fabric of wool.
patchwork	A piece of fabric produced by sewing pieces of different materials together.
quilting	A method of fastening together two or three layers of fabric (a base, a filling and top layer) with a diamond or square pattern of stitches.
tie-dye	A method of dyeing textiles to produce patterns by tying sections of the cloth together so they will not absorb the dye.
tjanting	A tool used for applying wax to the fabric. It has a handle, a reservoir to hold the wax and a spout.
