Dear Parents/Carers

Fully supervised care throughout each of the school holidays for children aged 3-12 from 8am to 18.00pm. Our intention is to provide a relaxing and friendly atmosphere in which children may participate in arts and crafts, play games, read or chat amongst themselves in a safe and secure environment. Each week has a theme to it and the activities and outings are based around that theme. A nutritious breakfast and afternoon light tea will be provided, Lunch at a cost of £2.00 a day. We always make arrangements for special diets and aim to provide healthy eating options.

We are a self-directed PLAY based provision.

“Play is a process that is freely chosen, personally directed and intrinsically motivated. That is, children and young people determine and control the content and intent of their play, by following their own instincts, ideas and interests, in their own way for their own reasons.”

This is very different from a classroom or early years environment, which can be (and sometimes needs to be) a very structured environment. We believe that after a term of learning, children want to come to us to have fun and freedom in an unstructured self-motivated way. Children will learn other skills that they need in the growing up process, but in a different way to school.

Example of some of the activities available throughout the week:

Various arts & crafts, painting, Hama beads, lots of outside games, (including basketball, football, tennis), construction play, time to relax with friends or read a book, lots and lots of free play and children’s choice!

Special Activities & Trips

At least once a week, we will organise a special activity or trip, which we find the children love. These are at an additional cost, to cover transport & entry fees. We ask that for trip days, (i.e. when we are off site) that your child(ren) arrive by the set departure time (which will be advertised in advance on the holiday programme), as it is unfair to other children to delay the trip if a child is late and therefore this may mean we have to leave without your child(ren).

Daily Routine

Each day in the holiday club is completely different and is based on what your children would like to do. However, as a guideline the daily holiday club is made up of:

8.00-10.00 -Breakfast and children start to arrive and engage in free play

10.00 - 11.00 -Specific activity 1

11.00 - 12.00 -Fruit snack and Specific activity 2

12.00 - 14:00 -Lunch and Free play (packed lunch to be provided by parents)

14.00 - 15.00 - Specific activity 3

15.00 - 16.00 - Specific activity 4

16.00 - 18.00 - Making dinner and free play - Home time.

What Food is provided

For children staying all day, breakfast (example of this would be Cereal, crumpets, fruit toast, toast, yogurt and fruit) and afternoon tea (wraps, sandwiches, hotdogs, pizza muffins, pasta, toasties) is provided, lunch at an extra cost of £2.00 a day (example sandwich, crisps, yogurt, fruit and a mini chocolate/cake bar) you can provide a healthy nutritious packed lunch (in a container with your child's name on). Please note BOSC is **NUT FREE ZONE**. Water is available to children throughout the day and squash and fresh juice is available at breakfast/light tea.

When should I book?

We normally open holiday club bookings around a month in advance of the holiday's once we have finalised the holiday programme. This is to ensure you are aware of the activities and trips we have organised each day.

Please find below our Summer Holiday Programme, we will open from –

Friday 23rd July

Reopen Monday 2nd August – Friday 27th August 2021

The majority of the activities were requested and planned by the children. All activities unless otherwise stated, will be accessible to all age groups and will adapt the activities accordingly to suit the children's needs and abilities.

Suitable clothing for indoor and outdoor activities is required: sun hats and sun cream during warmer days, or warm clothing and a waterproof when the weather is cooler or more variable.

Please can we have swim clothes and towel to keep at BOSC, we will send home on the Friday at the end of the week.

Children are welcome to bring some tuck shop money to buy some sweeties.
